

Arrhythmia Alliance Pace4Life (A-A P4L) is a charity that donates cardiac implantable electronic devices (CIED) such as pacemakers and implantable cardioverter defibrillators to people in need in low and middle-income countries (LMIC).



A-A P4L provides these life saving devices to people who desperately need them, but cannot afford them.

Every year, up to 2 million people die in LMIC because they don't have enough money for a lifesaving pacemaker operation.

A-A P4L AND CIED MISSIONS

- We send physiologists and pacing teams to LMIC to train local cardiac teams to implant CIED.
- We accept donations of equipment to send to programmes in LMIC.
- We accept used devices from hospitals and funeral directors.
- Each device is checked & any with more than five years of battery life are put through an FDA approved reconditioning process & sent for use in LMIC.
